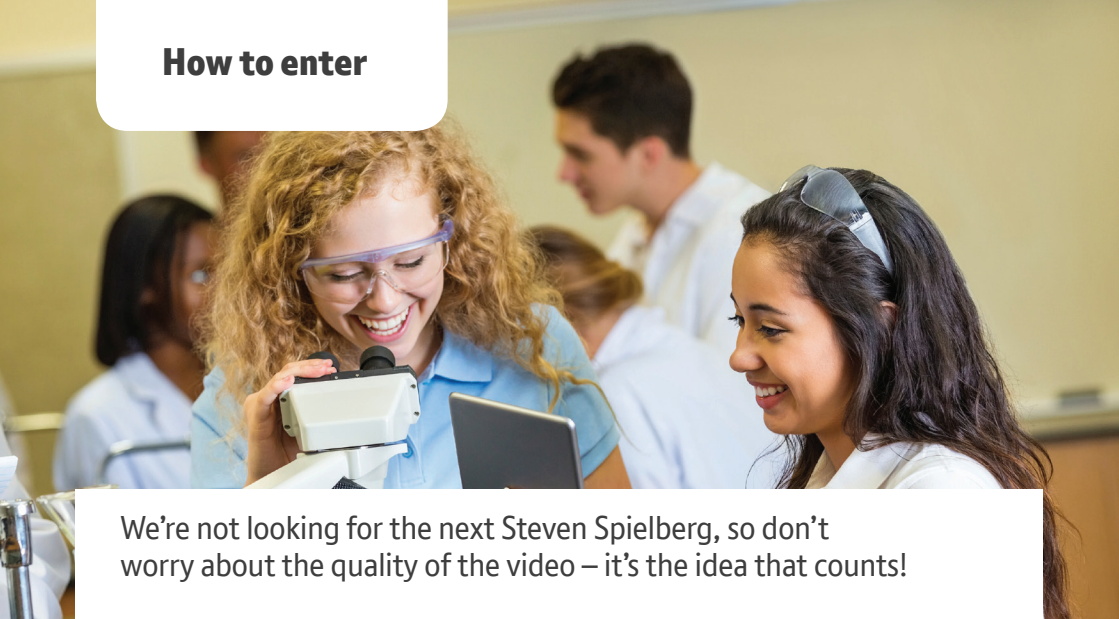

*Things you need to know

1. This competition is open to schools and academies in the KS 1-4 sector or their equivalent (i.e. teaching 5-16 year olds) and extra-curricular clubs; e.g. coding clubs either school led or other. The closing date for entries is Friday 5th October 2018. Our shortlist will be announced and published by Friday 26th October 2018. Winners will be announced by Friday 2nd November 2018.
2. A valid entry consists of submitting your school/ club's details and a link to your video both via our entry site. Entries that fail to provide sufficient details may not be judged. Only one entry per school in each category. If your school wishes to enter more than one category then you must submit different videos for each category entry. Additional entries from the same school may not be judged, in these instances the first fully delivered entry is the one that will be entered into judging.
3. There are four main prizes to be won, all of which are to be spent at BT Business Direct. We also have additional prizes from our partners to give away to some of our shortlisted schools. A credit will be applied to the accounts of the four schools who win a main monetary prize. First prize in one of the categories is £5,000 to spend at BT Business Direct and there are two runner-up prizes that will be donated from one of our partners. The runner up prizes are provided by brands that we partner with and can be opted in to during form submission. Prizes are not transferrable.

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
